Type design on show





Changes to website orders



We have finally decided to make the supply of the CD an option and the online ordering process has been altered to reflect this. A new addition is the 'ITT Proof of Licence PDF' which is included with a font download. It is unique to each order and shows the license details that previously appeared on the CD master. If required, a CD can still be added to your order for which a nominal cost is applied at checkout.

TypeBook


